now used as a Jew's Cemetery

Congregation Emanuel is far advanced, we hope it
may seem to your honorable Body the necessity
of having a place of interment connected therewith

It appears to your humble
petitioners that it would be more in accordance
with the general Custom of our Coreligionists
that such a Course had better be ~~undertaken~~ pursued
and you may be assured that if it should
be the wish of the Almighty to take from us
any member of our Creed whose circumstances
must admit a free Burial, it will ever be
our duty to grant the same

May we further presume
to add that without a cemetery no Israelite
Community or Congregation can be founded
on a proper Basis. Humbly soliciting your
honorable Body's assent to this petition

R Lambly Esq^r moved that altho he sent to the congregation Emanuel expressing his dissent to any conveyance of the Burial Ground at present as he did not consider the Congregation Emanuel for enough advanced in a state of good foundation or sound position, but as soon as he found the congregation in a fixed & flourishing position with a firm Basis, he would be ready to concur in any proposition having the object of the letter of the congregation Emanuel carried out, promising however as far as he was concerned that the congregation Emanuel should have all the rights & privileges of the cemetery untill such a conveyance is carried out.

and he further moved that the consideration of the same should be adjourned for 6 months

Neither of these motions
was seconded, & they therefore
fell to the ground

Motion made by A Simson Esq^r and seconded by D Jacoby Esq^r that the Burial Committee convey to the congregation Emanuel the Burial Ground in accordance with the resolution adopted the morning

in writing be sent to the Congregation Emanuel
informing them that their letter of the 13th
the May last had been taken into consideration

Mr. A. Simson, Mr. A. Blackman Esq^r &
Jacoby were ready and willing to convey
(if in their power) their portion of the Trusteeship
of the Burial ground to the Congregation

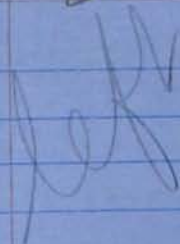
